YOUR ROLE

As the *Graphic Designer*, you will be developing environmental graphics, show graphics, information design presentations, signage and other visual aids for projects assigned inside the BMP Design Studio. You will be an integral part of the BMP Design team in the development of new concepts in the themed entertainment and resort industry. You will report to the Studio Creative Manager and be a member of the Studio Art team.

You will support the BMP Design Studio through ideation, illustration, and implementation of graphic design concepts.

 To ideate, you will work independently as a graphic designer and as part of a larger design team consisting of the project Producer, Art Studio and Production Design teams. You will develop environmental graphic design concepts via research decks, "look and feel" boards, and concept illustrations. You will also generate presentation



templates and work with the design and production team to place and update presentation visuals throughout various project phases. You will help present design concepts to clients and take part in internal and external (client) workshops and creative charettes.

- To illustrate, you will develop project show graphics, wayfinding signage, information graphics, and other graphic assets. You will produce graphic design sketches and generate graphic designs in multiple styles. Utilization of the BMP file organization systems and naming conventions will be key for updating project task lists and ensuring projects are on schedule.
- To implement, you will work with the Production Design team and the BMP
 Production Studio to turn graphic designs into reality. You will produce
 documentation packages containing color, material, and finish selection. You will
 generate print ready art files and provide notes and feedback on proofs and test
 prints as requested.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serve as a graphic designer on external client projects and internal BMP projects as assigned.
- Illustrate graphic design sketches, produce show graphics, wayfinding signage, information graphics, and other graphic assets.
- Work on multiple projects simultaneously with possible accelerated development deadlines.
- Integrate with the BMP Art Department and Production Design team on larger project development processes.
- Participate in creative workshops and blue-sky charrettes.
- Attend and participate in stakeholder / client meetings.
- Create documentation drawings and packages including research, "look and feel" boards, and finish references.
- Generate print ready art files and provide feedback on proofs and test prints.
- Creation, development, and revision of project creative update presentations for internal BMP meetings and for client pitches and presentations.
- Maintain and archive your work into project documentation systems.
- Communicate and coordinate with contractors and other consultants.
- Assist on site during installs and strikes to ensure project is executing per plans.
- Participate in job site visits (local and travel) to assist in site inspections to confirm compliance with show direction, design documents, and client requests.
- Maintain positive vendor and client relationships.
- Maintain confidentiality of all information.
- Assist in BMP studio support or other duties as assigned.
- ALWAYS share the BMP studio spirit with others internal and external
